Motion carried.
- B. LIQUOR LICENSE RENEWAL FOR JENNY WAYNES HIGH OCTANE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY, KARMA WELLS. Clerk/Treasurer Wells provided Council with a report on the license renewal for Jenny Wayne's High Octane. Baucke moved to approve the liquor license renewal for Jenny Wayne's High Octane. Second by Rutledge. Question. 7 ayes. Motion carried.
- A. FIRST READING ORDINANCE #1, SERIES OF 2017 ((AMENDING SECTIONS 15.04.020, 15.24.020 AND 15.28.020 OF THE YUMA MUNICIPAL CODE DESIGNATING CITY COUNCIL AS THE BOARD OF APPEALS IN THE INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE, 1994

 ABATEMENT OF DANGEROUS BUILDING CODE AND 1994 UNIFORM HOUSING CODE) SCOTT MOORE. Manager Moore explained this is to designate Council as the Board of Appeals. Haag moved to approve on first reading Ordinance #1, Series of 2017. Second by Rutledge. Question. 7 ayes. Motion carried.

- B. FIRST READING ORDINANCE #2, SERIES OF 2017 (REPEALING AND REENACTING CHAPTERS 15.10, 15.12, 15.32, 15.36 OF THE YUMA MUNCIPAL CODE AND ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE 2003 INTERNATIONAL RESIDENTIAL CODE, 2014 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 2003 FIRE CODE, 2003 INTERNATIONAL PLUMBING CODE, AND 2003 INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE) SCOTT MOORE. Manager Moore explained this is to amend and update some code language in these sections of the code. Discussion was held. Haag moved to approve on first reading Ordinance #2, Series of 2017. Second by Rutledge. Question. 7 ayes. Motion carried.
- C. APPOINTMENT OF THE BUILDING OFFICIAL AS THE FIRE CODE OFFICIAL UNDER THE 2003 INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE—SCOTT MOORE. Manager Moore mentioned this designates the Building Official as the Fire Code Official. Since we do not have a full time paid Fire Chief, the Fire Code Official reverts to the City Manager. Discussion was held. Swehla moved to approve the appointment of the Building Official as the Fire Code Official under the 2003 International Fire Code. Second by McCall. Question. 4 ayes. 3 nays (Baucke, Haag, Harms). Motion carried.
- **D. APPROVAL OF BILLS KARMA WELLS.** Clerk/Treasurer Wells handed out additional lists of bills. Baucke moved to approve the bills. Second by Harms. Question. 7 ayes. Motion carried.
- **E. PURCHASES IN EXCESS OF \$5,000 SCOTT MOORE.** There were no purchases in excess of \$5,000.
