REGULAR MEETING TUESDAY, MARCH 21, 2017

CALL TO ORDER - 7:30 P.M.

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR HARPER AND THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE WAS RECITED.

CORRECTIONS OR ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA

There were no corrections or additions to the agenda, but Clerk/Treasurer Wells stated Council Member Rutledge would be absent.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Haag moved to approve the March 21, 2017 agenda as presented. Second by McCall. Question. 6 ayes. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Haag moved to approve the regular meeting minutes of March 7, 2017 and the special meeting minutes of March 13, 2017. Second by McCall. Question. 6 ayes. Motion carried.

CITIZENS RECOGNITION AND INTRODUCTION/PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. Jim Pedersen, with Pedersen Planning Consultants, stated they are here to do interviews this week with staff and the public regarding the Comprehensive Plan. There is a public information meeting tomorrow.

ACTION ITEMS

- A. DISCUSSION ON FIRE/STORM SIRENS COUNCIL. Manager Moore explained we can set up the sirens to have different tones, at different times, at the Communications Center. It is recommended to use the sirens between 7 A.M. and 7 P.M. Haag moved to approve the sirens between 7 A.M. and 7 P.M. Second by Harms. Question. 6 ayes. Motion carried.
- **B. CITY OF YUMA MINOR SUBDIVISION SCOTT MOORE.** Manager Moore explained this is to subdivide the property to the east of the Waste Water Plant. The zoning will remain the same. Haag moved to approve the City of Yuma Subdivision. Second by Harms. Question. 6 ayes. Motion carried.
- C. LIQUOR LICENSE RENEWAL FOR PAPER MOON ENTERTAINMENT LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY, KARMA WELLS. Clerk/Treasurer Wells stated all the paperwork has been turned in by Paper Moon Entertainment to renew their liquor license. Baucke moved to approve the liquor license renewal for Paper Moon Entertainment. Second by Haag. Question. 6 ayes. Motion carried.
- D. FIRST READING ORDINANCE #3, SERIES OF 2017 (AMENDING TITLE 8 OF THE YUMA MUNICIPAL CODE BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW CHAPTER 8.26) SCOTT MOORE. Manager Moore stated this will add a new chapter 8.26 for nuisance abatement. Swehla moved to approve on first reading Ordinance #3, Series of 2017. Second by Harper. Question. 6 ayes. Motion carried.

- **E. APPROVAL OF BILLS KARMA WELLS.** Clerk/Treasurer Wells provided an additional list of bills. Haag moved to approve the bills. Second by McCall. Question. 6 ayes. Motion carried.
